

GUINNESS® IRISH MYSTERY NIGHT

Mystery Nights are a sequence of events acted out on a particular night, usually through dinner, in front of a group of guests ultimately leading to the untimely “disappearance” of one of the characters. The characters enact scenes in front of the guests, usually in conversational style. It has worked well in large restaurants – why not adapt it to your Irish Pub and create an unforgettable night?



HOW IT WORKS:

At the start of the night, the guests are shown to their tables to find Mystery Mail. This lists the different characters in that night's plot with a brief description of each. The guests use it during the night as a reference and might find it useful for jotting down valuable clues. During dinner the scenes are acted out, the length depends on the intricacy of the plot. After the crime has been committed, the actor in question disappears and the remaining characters distribute Mystery Answer Sheets to each table or guest. The guests must guess who committed the crime, how and why. The Mystery Mail is then collected and the winner determined. In the case of a draw, the table / guest with the motive closest to the truth is the winner.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Contact a company that runs these mystery events – they will organise the actors, props, timings
- Arrange a set meal that fits with the play's theme
- Advertise this event throughout your pub and local media
